

Highways and Car Parking

Parking & Access

Access to the Aldi store and new pharmacy for cars, bicycles and pedestrians will be provided from Zoar Street.

The new Aldi store will provide free customer parking with 115 spaces including six accessible, six parent-and-child and two electric vehicle charging bays. An additional 10 parking spaces will be provided for the new pharmacy.

Traffic

Aldi is undertaking a Transport Assessment as part of the planning application to establish the traffic effects of the development and to consider whether there is any need for mitigation.

This assessment will look at the operation of local roads both with and without the proposed development in place.

The scope of this assessment will be agreed with the Council's Highways Officer.

Deliveries

Aldi stocks a carefully selected range of approximately 1,800 lines, compared with supermarkets such as Asda or Sainsbury's that stock over 20,000 lines. As a result, an Aldi food store will require only three to four deliveries per day.

Delivery vehicles will also access the site via Zoar Street. We operate store deliveries outside of peak transport hours. All manoeuvring takes place within the site, and a unique delivery ramp arrangement removes the need for external activity. This process is not only efficient, but also reduces any potential noise disturbance to neighbouring properties.
