



Our proposal for Maghull offers:

- A new, modestly sized Aldi food store with a sales area of 1,332m²
- Outline plans for a drive thru coffee shop and restaurant
- Regenerating a brownfield site
- Creating around 75 jobs in total
- Around £5 million of investment into the local economy
- Increased shopping choice for local customers
- 123 car parking spaces including 8 disabled and 9 parent & child spaces

- Free customer car parking
- Two free electric vehicle charging points with passive infrastructure for a further 22 spaces
- Attractive landscaping incorporated around the site to enhance its appearance
- A high-quality design, which offers a contemporary shopping experience
- Additional employment opportunities during construction and via the supply chain

Of the 75 new jobs created through the scheme, the new Aldi food store would create approximately 40 new jobs, including managerial positions. Aldi aims to provide flexible jobs for local people, and more employment opportunities would also be available through the construction of the development.

Aldi employees receive industryleading wages above the National Living Wage, proven opportunities for career progression, high levels of training, and a guaranteed minimum of 20 hours' work per week.

It is Aldi's aim to recruit staff locally for its new stores and, as a result, most staff live close to the store where they work.
