



Being a good neighbour

We are proud to be at the heart of local communities across the country. To continue our community-led culture, we have set out a number of “neighbour-friendly” practices:

- We aim for our store managers to be familiar with the local area, allowing them to react quickly and sympathetically to local issues when they arise
- We use a unique delivery system, enabling products to be transferred directly from the vehicle straight into the store, without the need for external movement of goods. This reduces external activity and limits any potential disruption
- Unlike most supermarkets, which operate extended or 24-hour opening periods, our stores typically open between 8am and 10pm Monday to Saturday, and between 10am and 4pm on Sundays
- We are committed to being responsible neighbours, and will work closely with the local community to ensure that any disturbance is kept to a minimum, from construction right through to when the store is open

Noise & Lighting

Aldi is committed to being a good neighbour, therefore consideration for noise and lighting is paramount to the design process.

The store has been orientated to allow for a dedicated delivery area which will be enclosed by a close boarded timber fence to reduce noise transfer. In terms of lighting, the store will have car park lighting that is turned off approximately 1hr after closing time with the internal store lighting reduced to 1/3 during a late shift. The residential development will have street lighting as typical for a suburban estate road.

Aldi has commissioned noise impact assessments which will be submitted as part of the planning application.



Construction considerations

Should Aldi receive planning permission, we will agree a full and detailed Construction Management Plan with Sefton Council prior to beginning construction works.

A temporary access would be created off A59 Northway, where the site access will be created. It is anticipated that temporary traffic lights may be used to construct the access road, but these will only be in operation during quieter periods. The only likely periods of closure would be to undertake resurfacing works which would happen during the hours of 7.30pm and 11pm only.

Aldi’s team will be accessible throughout construction. Our site manager will be on hand to answer any issues or take up any concerns from local residents to ensure that any disruptions are minimised and/or dealt with effectively.
