



Improved choice for Maghull

Aldi has been working on plans to invest in a new community food store in Maghull for several years. Currently there are many loyal Aldi customers within the local area who have to travel further afield for their weekly shop, to areas such as Netherton and Thornton, costing residents time and money.

As customers continue to look for better-value brands to help make their money go further, it is important that residents have access to a wide range of shopping facilities. The introduction of a new Aldi food store in Maghull would improve the immediate local retail offering, creating more competition and improving choice for the local community.

Aldi is well known for selling a variety of high-quality products at discounted prices. Our customers save between 30% and 40% on their shopping without compromising on quality, with everyday items available at low prices. A store in this location would allow nearby residents to carry out their food shopping without the use of a car.

We believe there is an opportunity to redevelop this site, serve residents closer to their homes whilst cutting down travel times, traffic movements and keeping spend within the local economy.
