We are proud to be at the heart of local communities across the country. As part of our community-led culture, we have set out a number of “neighbour-friendly” practices.

- Aldi aims to recruit its store managers and staff from the local area, which allows them to react quickly and sympathetically to any local issues
- Unlike most supermarkets, which operate 24-hour opening periods, our stores typically open between 8am and 10pm Monday to Saturday, and between 10am and 4pm on Sundays
- Aldi only stocks around 1,800 lines, compared to a typical supermarket which stocks 15,000 – 40,000, meaning Aldi food stores only need around 3-4 deliveries per day
- Aldi’s unique delivery system enables products to be transferred from the vehicle straight to store, without the need for external movement – minimising the potential for any disruption
- We are committed to being responsible neighbours and work closely with the local community to ensure that any disturbance is kept to a minimum, from construction right through to when the store is open.
